Student Exchange Program 2018

The Damjanich János Museum has a strong commitment to give an opportunity for foreign students to familiarize themselves with the archaeological methods practiced in Hungary and to look into the material culture of the country.

For the above reasons the Museum would like to announce their intention to engage a cooperation as student exchange for a brief period (**maximum**

4 weeks) of excavations with the School of Archaeology and Museology, Peking University.

During the stay of students of the School of Archaeology and Museology, Peking University in Hungary, all costs of accommodation will be covered by the Damjanich János Museum.

The Museum would also host the visit and agree to provide basic facilities.



Details of Field Practice in 2017

In accordance with the Hungarian Heritage Law, the Damjanich János Museum – as directorate of Jász-Nagykun-Szolnok County Museums – had been appointed to conduct the excavations of the following areas:

1. **Szolnok Castle Site:** ca. 20,00m²;
Ottoman period 奥斯曼时代[ca. 15th – 16th
AD]----Field Works



2. **Kunszentmárton site I:** Neolithic settlement section 新石器时代 [6000-4500 BC] settlement ----Expected field works/Documentation;



3. **Kunszentmárton site II:** Bronze Age 青铜器时代 [ca. 3000–900 BC] settlement section; Roman Barbaricum&Migration Period 萨尔马提亚人 settlement section and cemetery----- Expected field works/Documentation;

Please note that the government might change its excavation projects therefore the above details are subject to alteration without notice.

Period of Excavations/Documentation:

1st May – 1st August, 2018

Costs of visit:

All costs of accommodation, inner transportation and basic facilities will be covered by the host institution. In case of interest, the Museum would also offer lectures held in Chinese/English introducing the Hungarian cultural heritage system and organised trips to significant historical places.¹

All costs of flight tickets, health insurance and living expenses should be covered by the visiting students.
